



“3 Strikes, You’re Out” Disciplinary Policy For the 2010 Season

Santa Clara Westside Little League’s “3 Strikes, You’re Out” disciplinary policy establishes the range of discipline to be used for any/all violations of the League’s **Parent Code of Conduct Policy** as well as any other issues deemed to be inappropriate behavior at Santa Clara Westside Little League. This policy applies to both the general and player memberships, as well as to parents, guardians, volunteers, spectators and fans.

Strike 1 – In the event of a first violation, a penalty to be imposed based upon the infraction, ranging from, but not limited to:

- Warning;
- Game(s) suspension (which includes all other LL activities during the period, including practices/events);
- Expulsion.

Strike 2 – In the event of a second violation, a penalty to be imposed based upon the infraction, ranging from, but not limited to:

- Game(s) suspension (which includes all other LL activities during the period, including practices/events);
- Expulsion

Strike 3 – In the event of a third violation:

- Expulsion.
